As you are all aware, there was a very lucky escape for one of the Christ Church family a couple of weeks ago. The fact that Sophie escaped with the injuries she did is miraculous!

Since the accident I have noted that far fewer people are parking on the road that leads to school and hopefully this has carried into Harden Road too.

I have also been in contact with the Local Authority via the 'A Stars' team. As a result we have set up a range of road safety training opportunities over the coming months. The sessions are to teach pupils about the dangers of crossing such busy roads. There will be sessions for parents and pupils in Reception and Year 1, while Years 3 and 4 will carry out a more in-depth unit of work within the classroom.

We will also be looking at a '5 minute' drop off zone, whereby parents can leave their cars away from the school and walk just a couple of minutes to the site. This will help to clear both Harden Road and Awlmakers Grove!

I hope that you will get on-board with the school and the A Stars team as we work to ensure the safety of all our pupils at the start and end of the school day when they are most at risk.

We have definitely used up our quota of luck and I fear that next time there is an accident there will not be such a positive outcome!
