I can describe the ways in which the Church, Mosque and Gurdwara help the religious community. I can consider questions about worship and sacred spaces making connections and explaining my point of view.</i> <i>I can explain how and why a Church is a sacred and important place for Christians.</i> <i>I can explain how and why a Mosque is a sacred and important place for Muslims.</i> <i>I can explain how and why a Gurdwara is a sacred and important place for Sikhs.</i> <i>I understand that many people can feel more spiritual in natural environments than in holy buildings.</i> <i>I can make connections between worship and holy buildings in two or more religions.</i>
