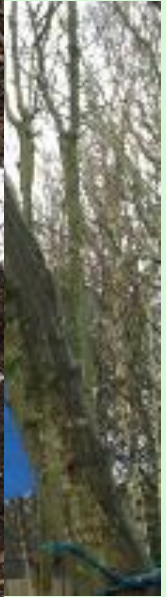

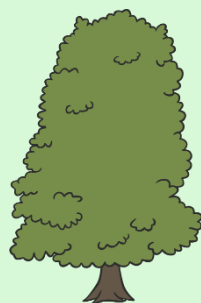

# Forest School Rules

Walk to the forest together and sit around the fire circle. Recap on our rules and the importance of each rule.

- nothing in mouth
- walk with sticks carefully
- take care of the environment
  - flora and fauna
- walk round the outside of the fire circle
- come back when 'sticky elbows' is called or when you hear the whistle
- You must be able to see an adult at all times
- **EMERGENCY** - know when to return to an adult.



# Fire Rules

Keep safe when by the fire circle at ALL TIMES.

Listen to the safety instructions.

Use fire gloves.

Make sure you are with an adult.

# Tool work Rules

*You should listen to the safety instructions.*

*Stay a safe distance of the tool zone and keep within the designated boundary.*

*Allow tool workers to concentrate when working with tools.*

*If you have questions or queries, go to an adult who is not working with tools.*

*I can create a shelter with a group using the previously taught timber hitch.*

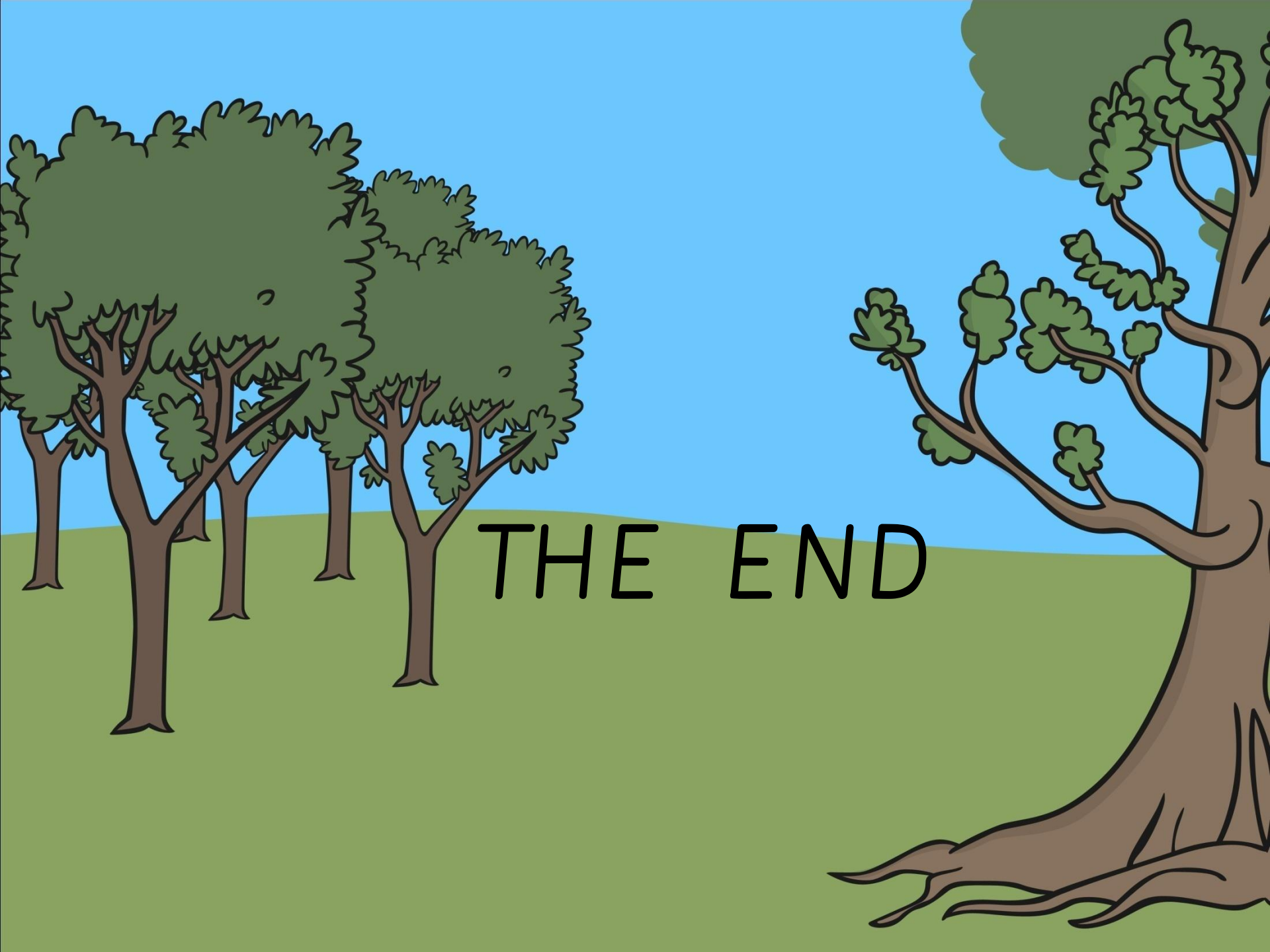
*I can cook on an open fire safely.*
