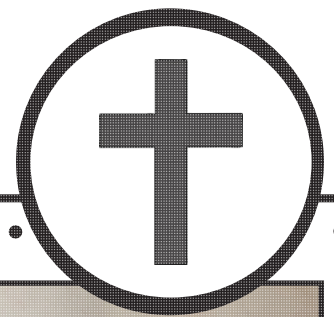
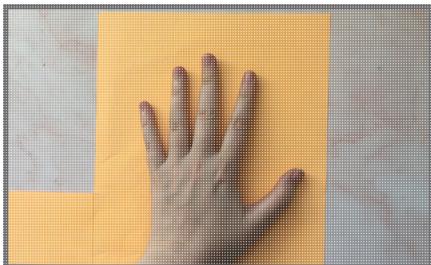


# Easter Good Friday Handprint Craft



## You will need:

- Colourful paper or card
- Black paper or card
- Scissors
- Glue
- A pencil or pen
- (Optional) A plate



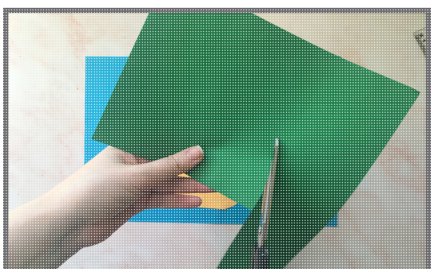
1) Place your hand on a piece of colourful paper with the fingers spread. We recommend yellows and oranges for this part of the craft so your fingers look like sunbeams. Draw around your hand.



2) Then cut out the outline. Repeat this process so you have two handprints. You may want to use three handprints if using especially small hands.



3) Overlap the hands on a piece of blue paper for the sky. Position them near the centre of the paper with the fingers facing upwards.



4) Then, cut a semi-circle from a piece of green paper.



5) Position the green mound over the bottom of the two hands so it looks like a hill with the sun peeking over the top.



6) Cut a cross from black paper and place it at the centre of the design. Once happy with the positions of all of the elements, you can glue down the pieces of paper.



7) You could finish here. This would be a lovely design for the front of a DIY Easter card, or as an activity to follow learning about Good Friday.



8) We also found the artwork looked effective when we placed a plate on top of the design and drew around it before cutting around the outline.
