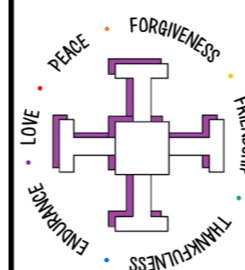

Chicks Update



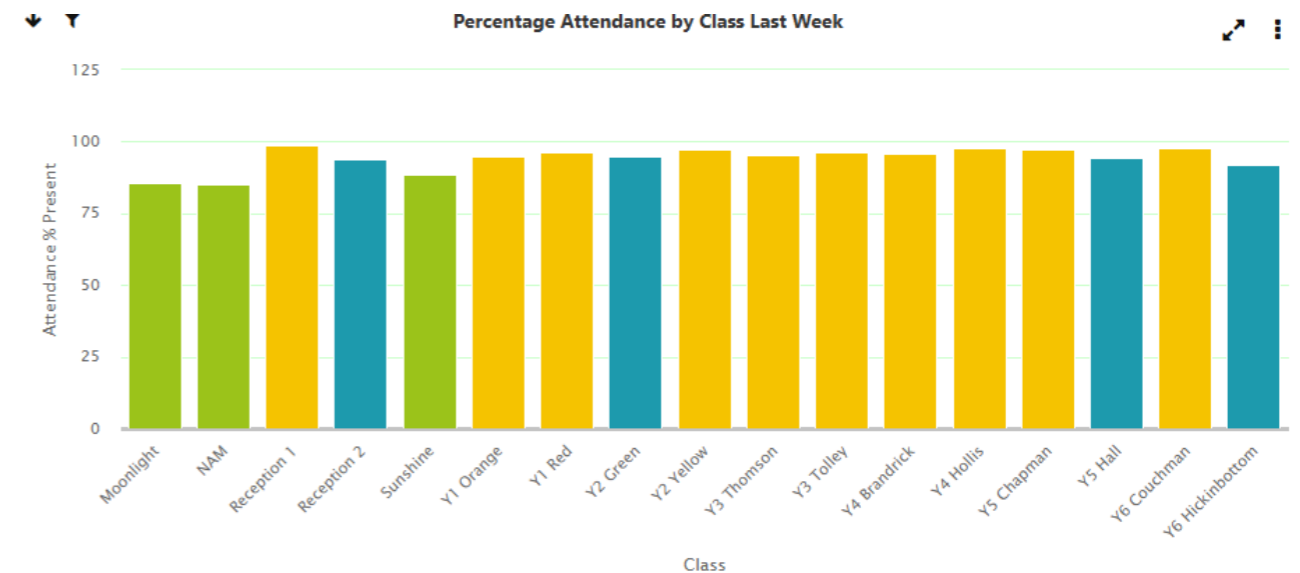
I am very pleased to share that our School Chicks have settled into their new home well and are loving life.
