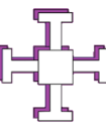

- Exploring repeats in stories, songs and patterns.

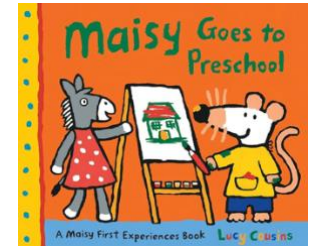
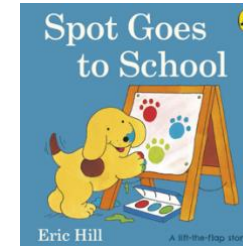


RE

- Our school value: Love 

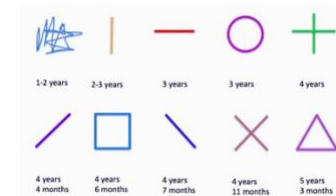
Literacy

- Key Texts: Spot goes to school and Maisie goes to Nursery.



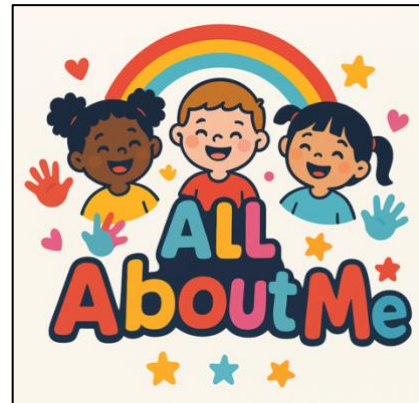
Draw and talk

Expressive Arts and Design

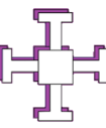
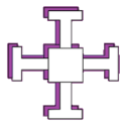
- Junk modelling our homes, self-portraits using pencil and paint.

- Recognising different emotions.





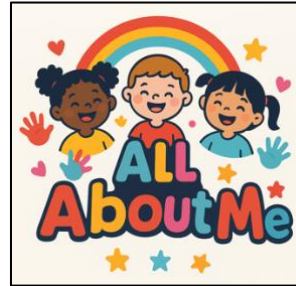

Autumn 1

Maths

- Find more or fewer – Who has more sweets?
- Can you spot shapes and patterns around you? What shape is the door?
- Follow instructions using the words **in**, **on** and **under**.



Literacy

Draw and Talk

- Talk about our story each week and share who is in it.
- Engage in word play – can you say the syllables in words? E.g. Happy – Hap-py – Happy
- Can you play I spy?

Expressive Arts and Design

- Can you sing our song of the week at home?
- Can you make your own song?



Physical Development

- Can you move in different ways?
Can you run, walk, hop safely?

RE

- Talk about your family at home – Can you name the different people in your family?
- Show love to people at home. How can you show them love?

PSHE

- Recognise and talk about your emotions. Can you make a happy or sad face?
- Talk about groups you belong to.

Understanding the World

- Can you describe where you live? What is your house like?
- Can you spot any changes to the seasons? What do you see outside that looks different on our trees?
